

Redirection

If you want to **redirect** a visitor from one page to another, in that case you can write the following code:

```
Response.Redirect("Services.aspx?uid =" + 33);
```

Here in the above code the visitor is redirected to **Services.aspx** Page with a Value **33**, whose Key is **uid**.

Query String

If you want to pass value from one page to another through URL in that case you will be able to use **QueryString**.

If you pass a value through an URL, while the URL is like:

```
http://mysite.com/info.aspx?pageid=22
```

In such case, to get the Value **22** with Key **pageid** in the **info.aspx** Page, you can write the **following code** in **info.aspx** Page:

```
string pageNo = Request.QueryString["pageid"].ToString();
```

Session

Session is such a variable that carries a value from one page to another. If you define a Session Variable in a page, you will be able to call and use this Variable in a second page.

To define a **Session Variable** you can write the following code:

```
Session["User_Name"] = "Nirjhor Anjum";
```

Next, you can use the same variable in another page as follows:

```
LabelSessionUser.Text = Session["User_Name"].ToString();
```
